## Expertise

The MCCF influences the expansion of French-language services by focusing on key issues such as bilingual capacity building, service-delivery innovation and cross-sector collaboration. Their work is organized in order to stimulate progress in two main areas:

- Increasing access to government services in French across the country
- Enhancing promotion of the Canadian Francophonie
